Executive Summary:

All Yellowstone River closures have been lifted south of Livingston today, September 23.

The SECC is monitoring weather status and precipitation across the state for any adverse effects. Winds in excess of 50 mph can be expected in south-central and south-eastern Montana on Saturday. Please monitor National Weather Service Offices for updated watches and warnings.
